Vending at the Saltworks Appalachian Homecoming

The Saltworks Appalachian Homecoming will be held at the Historic Saltworks Pioneer Village on Railroad Ave. in Manchester, KY on May 23 – 25 2019. This is an entirely outdoor event and vendors are responsible for their own tents and protection from weather. Vendors are required to bring your own extension cords to reach electrical panels. Electricity will be limited to 110 volts and 20 amps.

The vendor fee is \$50 for one booth space (10x10 or 12x12). A double booth is \$100.00. This fee includes vendor armbands for two workers. If additional workers are needed. Exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis and all children 12 and under are free.

Vendor set up will begin Thursday morning after 9:00am on May 23. All Vendors are required to be in place by 4:30pm and open for business by 5pm on Thursday and Friday and Noon on Saturday. Private vehicles are allowed ONLY on the festival grounds before 4:30pm on Thursday and Friday, and until 11am on Saturday.

Vendors may primitive camp behind their booths after the concert each night.

Vendors must be open for the duration of the festival.

*Friday, May 24, 5pm – 11pm

*Saturday, May 25, 12am – 11pm

2019 Vendor Rules & Regulations

The Saltworks Appalachian Homecoming will be held at the Historic Saltworks Pioneer Village on Railroad Ave. in Manchester, KY on May 23 – 25 2019. This is an entirely outdoor event and vendors are responsible for their own tents and protection from weather. You are required to bring your own extension cords to reach electrical panels. Electricity will be limited to 110 volts and 20 amps.

The vendor fee is \$50 for one booth space (10x10 or 12x12). A double booth is \$100.00. This fee includes vendor armbands for two workers. If additional workers are needed. Exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis and all children 12 and under are free.

Vendor set up will begin Thursday morning at 9:00am, May 23. All Vendors are required to be in place by 4:30pm and open for business by 5pm on Thursday and Friday and open for business at noon on Saturday. The music begins at 5pm on Thursday and Friday and 12noon on Saturday. We will be having a KIDS DAY on Friday this year so plan on being open during the day for that – we will tell specific times asap. Private vehicles are ONLY allowed on festival grounds before 4:30pm on Thursday and Friday, until 11am on Saturday.

Vendors may set up “primitive camp” behind their booths after the concert each night. There will be security all night long.

Vendors must be open for the duration of the festival.

*Friday, May 24, 5pm – 11pm

*Saturday, May 25, 11am – 11pm

Vendors must vacate the Pioneer Village by noon on Sunday, May 27, 2019
